

A Haunting We Go Mini Album

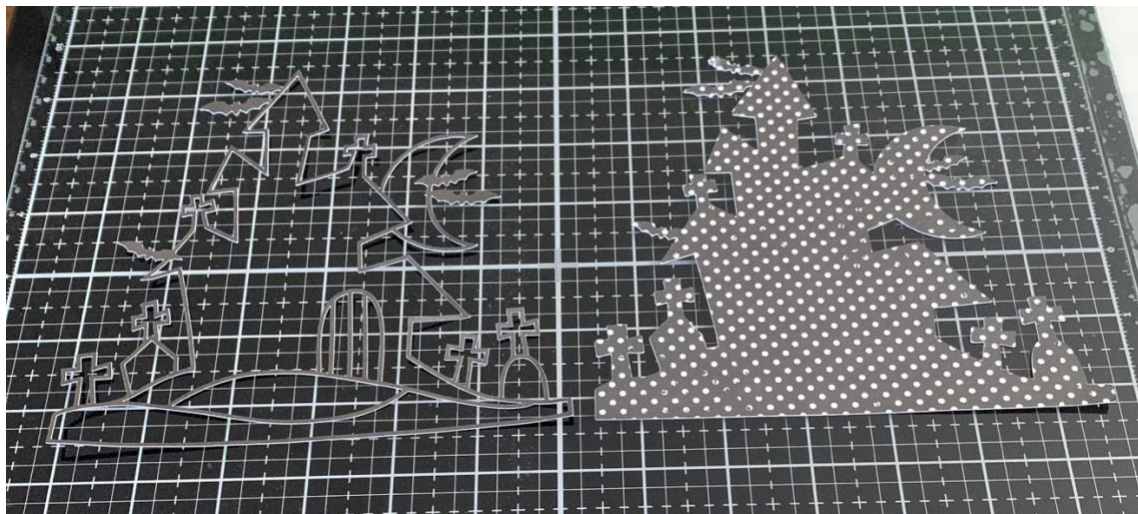


To create this mini album, you'll need the Simple Vintage Halloween Creative Kit, Vintage Halloween Add on Kit, 12x12 Basics Kit – Simple Vintage October 31st, Haunted House Cut File, and Web Background Cut File.

To start, you'll need to choose four patterned papers out of the Halloween Creative Kit. I used In the Moonlight, Happy Haunting, Boo to You! And Simply Wicked. Cut out the Haunted House Cut File out of each of the patterned papers. Make sure that you are only cutting out the shape.



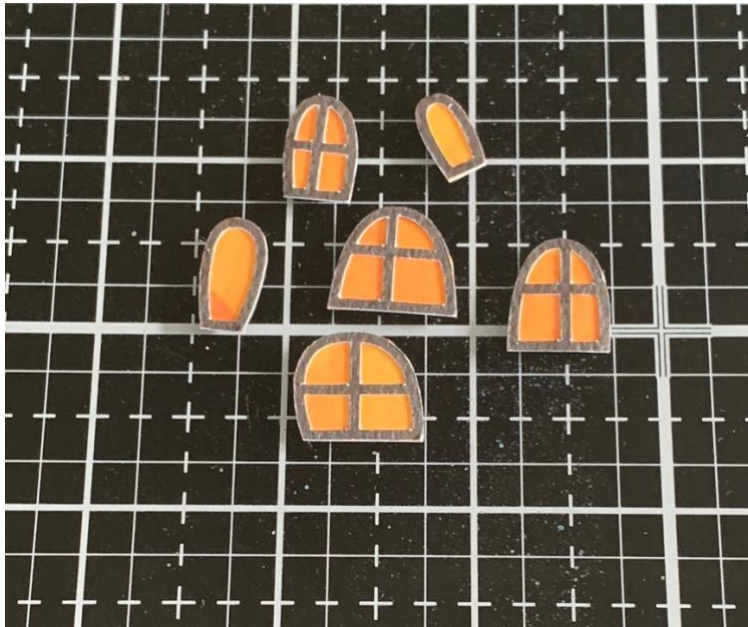
Choose one more patterned paper and cut out another Haunted House. I used Costume Parade. Make sure that you are only cutting out the shape. You are going to cut out the Haunted House this time out of Color Vibe Textured Cardstock – Black. Make sure that you are cutting out the haunted house with the contours.



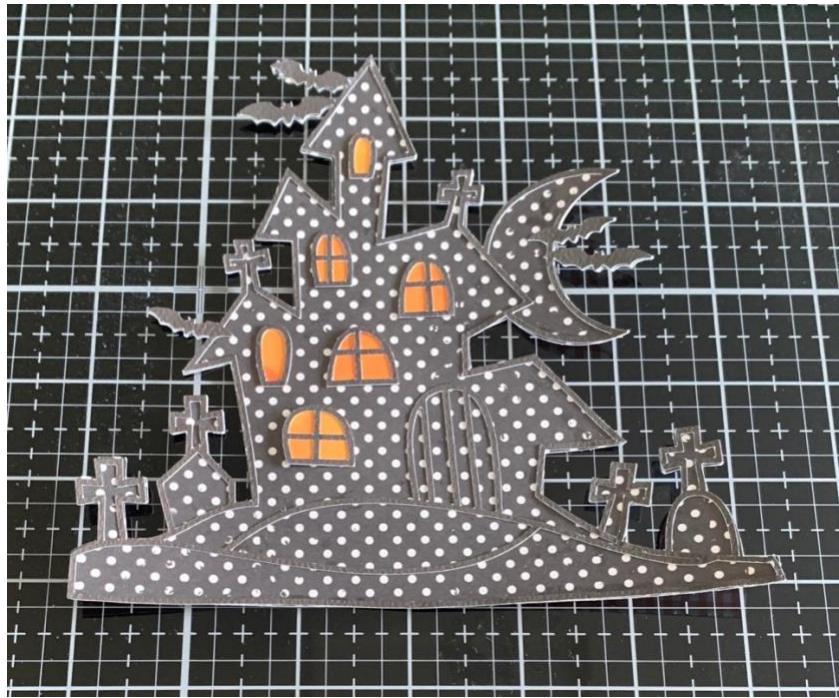
Adhere the outline haunted house to the plain shape haunted house.



The window frames that would have been cut out when you cut out the detailed haunted house, you will now need. Out of the 12x12 Basics Kit – Simple Vintage October 31st, take out either the orange or yellow patterned paper. Adhere the window frames to the paper and cut around the window frames.



Adhere the windows to the left-hand side of the haunted house as desired.



To finish the front cover of the mini album, out of the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the A haunting we go and happy haunting word strips. Ink the edges of both word strips using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam. Adhere the two-word strips to the bottom right side of the haunted house.



Flip the front cover over and we will work on page 2. Cut out the Web Background Cut File from Color Vibe Textured Cardstock – Black. Trim the web down so that it is smaller. Cut a photo mat out of the Color Vibe Textured Cardstock – Dandelion that measures 2 ½" x 3 ½". From the 4x4 Elements paper, cut out the Cutest Pumpkin word strips. From the Journal Elements paper, cut out the border with pumpkin and bingo card. Out of the Page Pieces you'll need two bats. Distress the edges of the border and photo mat. Ink the edges of all the pieces except for the web using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the web on the left side of the house. Adhere the pumpkin border 1/8" from the bottom and 3/8" from the right of the house. Adhere the photo ¼" from the bottom and ¾" from the left side of the house. Adhere the word strips to the right side of the photo mat. Adhere the two bats as desired towards the top of the house. Add five enamel dots as desired on the page.



For Page 3, I used the In the Moonlight haunted house shape. Fussy cut from the Journal Elements paper, the details label. Fussy cut the doily and circle with bingo card out of the 4x4 Elements paper. Fussy cut the web with a bow out of the 3x4 Elements paper. From the Chipboard Clusters, you'll need a bat. From the Page Pieces, you'll need to choose two hearts. From the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the super scary word strip. Distress the edges of the circle with bingo card and detail label. Ink the edges of all the images except the haunted house using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the doily 1/8" from the left and 2 1/4" from the top of the haunted house. Adhere the web with bow 3/4" from the bottom and almost all the way to the right-hand side of the haunted house. Foam square the circle with bingo card 3/4" from the right and 1/8" from the bottom. Adhere the bat in behind the top left side of the circle with bingo card. Adhere the two hearts to the bottom right of the circle with bingo card. Adhere the super scary word strip below the happy Halloween on the circle with bingo card. Use adhesive and foam squares to adhere the details label to the bottom right of the circle with bingo card, it will sit slightly over top of the hearts. To finish the page, add five enamel dots as desired.



Page 4 is the backside of the Moonlight Haunted House. From the Page Pieces, you'll need the black label, Boo to You circle, two bats, two hearts and 2 ½" of the border. Distress the edges of the label and circle. Ink the edges of all the elements except the haunted house.



Adhere the border strip ½" from the bottom and 1" from the right of the haunted house. Adhere the Boo to You circle to the middle of the black label. Foam square the black label to the middle of the haunted house. Adhere the two bats as desired to the top portion of the black label. Use adhesive and foam squares to adhere the two hearts to the bottom left side of the Boo to You circle. To finish the page, add four decorative brads as desired.

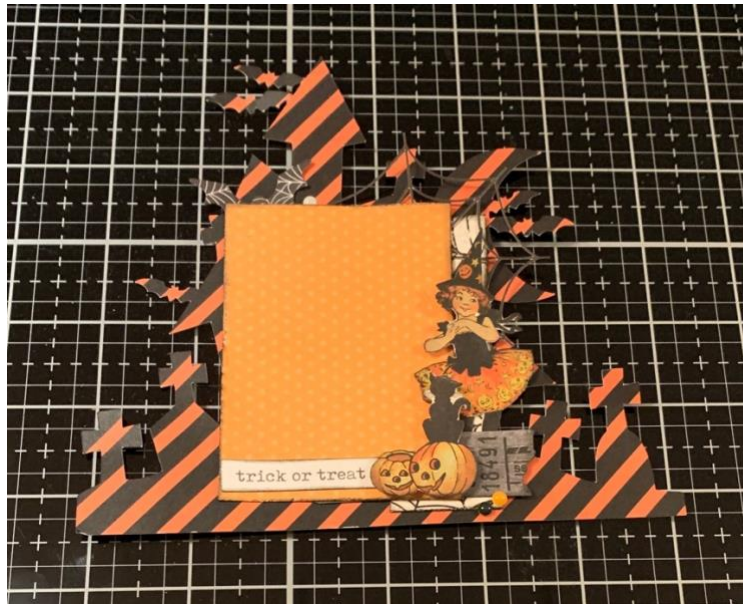


For page 5, you'll need the Happy Haunting haunted house. From the Journal Elements paper, cut a piece that measures 1" x 3 1/2", you will use the cobweb side. From the bright orange color vibe cardstock, cut a piece that measures 2 1/2" x 3 1/2". You will need to cut another web background cut file out of a piece of black color vibe cardstock. Trim down to the desired size. Out of the Page Pieces, you'll need the Trick or Treat word strip. Out of the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the grey ticket, bat, girl witch and cat on pumpkins. Fussy cut around the girl witch and cat on pumpkins. Distress the edges of the cobweb piece and the bright orange piece. Ink the edges of all the pieces except the haunted house using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the cobweb patterned paper piece 3/4" from the right and 1/8" from the bottom of the haunted house. Adhere the web to the top right side of the cobweb paper. Adhere the bat to the top left side of the haunted house as desired. Adhere the grey ticket 1/4" from the bottom

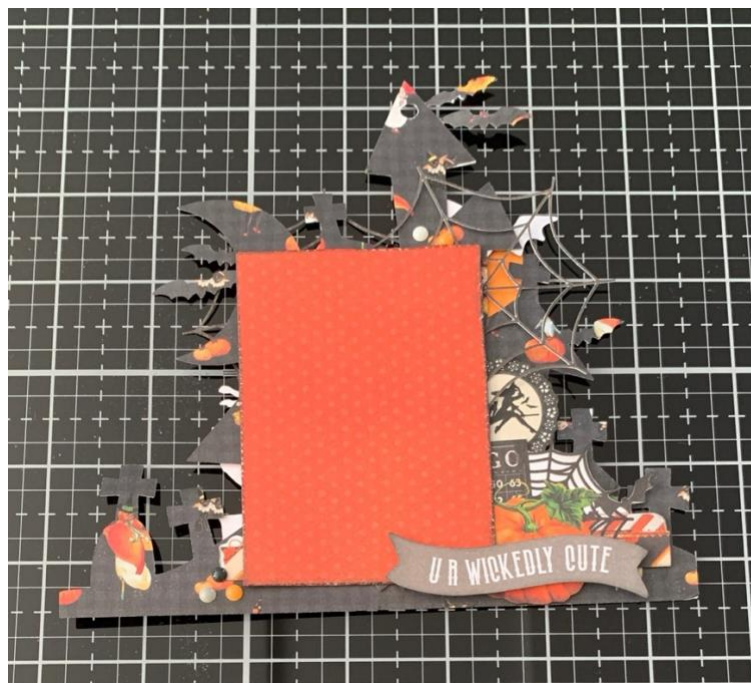
and 1 ½” from the right of the haunted house. Adhere the bright orange cardstock photo mat ¼” from the bottom and 1 3/8” from the left. Adhere the girl witch to the right side of the photo mat as desired. I tucked her feet underneath the grey ticket. Adhere the trick or treat word strip to the bottom left side of the photo mat. Use foam squares to adhere the cat sitting on pumpkins to the bottom right corner of the photo mat. To finish the page, add three enamel dots as desired.



For page 6, flip page 5 over. From the pumpkin color vibe cardstock, cut a piece that measures 2 ½” x 3 ½”. You will need to cut another web background cut file out of a piece of black color vibe cardstock. Trim down to the desired size. Out of the Page Pieces, you’ll need the remainder of the border strip. Out of the Bits & Pieces, you’ll need the doily with witch and grey u r wickedly cute banner. Fussy cut around the border strip. Distress the edges of the pumpkin piece. Ink the edges of all the pieces except the haunted house using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the web background to the top right side of the haunted house. Adhere the border strip $\frac{3}{8}$ " from the bottom and $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the right of the haunted house. Adhere the witch doily slightly above the border strip. Adhere the pumpkin photo mat $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom and $1\frac{3}{4}$ " from the left. To finish the page, add five enamel dots.



For page 7, you'll need the Boo to You! haunted house. From the Journal Elements paper, you'll need the black & orange striped journal element and cut a piece from the plaid side that measures $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3". From the 3x4 Elements you'll need the Eat Drink word strips and the cats in the circle. Fussy cut around the cats in circle and cut the Eat Drink quote into five-word strips. Out of the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the black word ticket. Distress the edges of all the pieces except for the word strips and haunted house piece. Ink the edges of all the pieces except the haunted house using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the plaid strip $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the bottom and $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " from the left of the haunted house. Adhere the striped journal element $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom and 1" from the right of the haunted house. Foam square the black tag 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the right and 2" from the top of the haunted house. Use adhesive and foam squares to adhere the circle with cat $\frac{5}{8}$ " from the bottom and $1 \frac{1}{8}$ " from the left. To finish the page, add four decorative brads as desired.

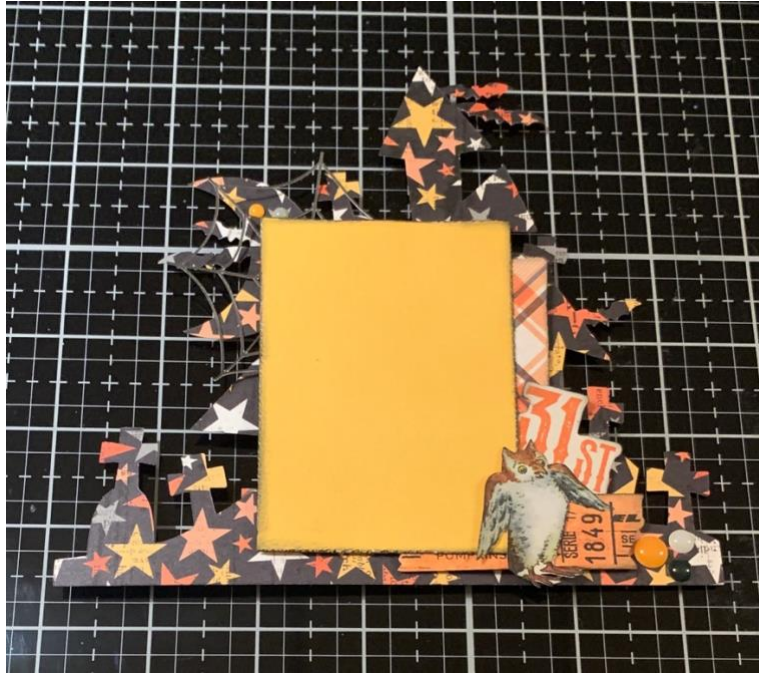


For page 8, flip page 7 over. From the dandelion color vibe cardstock, cut a piece that measures $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $3 \frac{1}{2}$ ". You will need to cut another web background cut file out of a piece of black color vibe cardstock. Trim down to the desired size. From the 3x4 Elements paper, cut a piece from the plaid side that measures 1" x 3". Out of the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the orange ticket, 31st and owl. Fussy cut around the owl. Distress the edges of all the pieces except for the web, owl,

and haunted house. Ink the edges of all the pieces except the haunted house and web using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the plaid patterned paper piece 1" from the right and 2 ¼" from the top of the haunted house. Adhere the web to the top left side of the haunted house. Foam square the orange ticket 1/8" from the bottom and ¾" from the right of the haunted house. Adhere the dandelion cardstock photo mat ¼" from the bottom and 1 ¾" from the left. Adhere the 31st to the right side of the photo mat as desired. I tucked it slightly underneath the orange ticket. Adhere the owl to the bottom right corner of the photo mat. To finish the page, add five enamel dots as desired.



For page 9, you'll need the Simply Wicked haunted house. From the Journal Elements paper, you'll need the square with bat washi tape. Cut around the journal element so there isn't any patterned paper around it. From the 3x4 Elements you'll need the pumpkin image. Fussy cut around the pumpkin image. Out of the Bits & Pieces, you'll need the star tag, orange label and Happy Halloween banner. Distress the edges of all the pieces except for the banner and haunted house piece. Ink the edges of all the pieces except the haunted house using Black Soot Distress Ink and a blending tool with foam.



Adhere the journal element with bat washi tape 2 ¼" from the top and 1 ½" from the left of the haunted house. Adhere the star tag ½" from the right and 2 ¼" from the top of the haunted house. Adhere the orange label 1 5/8" from the left and 5/8" from the bottom of the haunted house. Use adhesive and foam squares to adhere the pumpkin element 2" from the right and ¼" from the bottom. Use adhesive and foam squares to adhere the Happy Halloween Banner 1/8" from the bottom and 1" from the right. To finish the page, add five decorative brads as desired.



Page 10 is the backside of page 9 and remains blank. To finish the mini album, punch a hole at the top and hold it together using a jump ring.
