Supplies:
-(1) $12 \times 12$ " CS base (you won't see much of this base)
-(6) minimum $3 \times 12^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{PP}$ (these will be in strips layered on top of your base and would work best if small patterns or distressed solids)
-(3) min $2 \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ PP (i used 2 PP and then backed one of our Cut File Borders)
-PHOTOS: (2) 4x6" V ... i also used CS to mat these)
-Alphas and Embellishments

## Instructions:

- $12 \times 12$ " CS base
-Cut (6) PP pieces on diagonals with widest end ranging from 2" to 2 3/4"
- Slightly overlap pieces as you lay them from top
to bottom; Wide edge at one end then narrow, then wise, narrow etc ...
-This will create your background to your photos
- Mat (2) $4 \times 6$ " photos onto CS 1/4" larger than the size of your photos
-Cut (1) PP to $1 \times 6$ 1/4"; Adhere these 2 photos with the 1" PP strip in between
-Cut (1) PP to $11 / 2 \times 101 / 4$ "; Adhere at bottom of photos, slightly overlapping the bottom of the photos
- Add a border just overlapping the bottom of the last PP strip; I used one of our border Cut Files
-Title and Embellish as desired
