14 Mixed Media Page

To create this mixed media page, you'll need the NEW Heart Background Cut File, Be Mine Bundle, Hearts & Garland Wreath Cut File, ABC Background Cut File, Currently Journaling Clear Stamp Set, Retro Daisy Stencil, and Happy Hearts Creative Kit.

To start, you'll need to cut a piece of white cardstock that measures 6" x 8". Place the Retro Daisy 6x8 Stencil on the right side of the white cardstock piece. Using a palette knife, put Texture Paste Opaque Matte through the stencil as desired. Remove the stencil. Allow the texture paste to dry before you move on to the next step.



Once the texture paste has dried, using a blending tool with foam, blend Cracked Pistachio Distress Oxide Ink on part of the stenciled image as desired. Using a blending tool with foam, blend Kitsch Flamingo Distress Oxide Ink on the remaining stenciled part. Spritz the ink with water. Allow time for the water to dry.



Next, you'll need to splatter the cardstock piece using a paint brush and Kitsch Flamingo Distress Spray Stain and then Cracked Pistachio Distress Spray Stain. Clean your paintbrush in between each colour of Distress Spray Stain. Allow the splatter spray to dry.



Once the splattered spray has dried, you'll need the filled in heart and the outlined heart from the Currently Journaling Clear Stamp Set. Apply Kitsch Flamingo Distress Oxide Ink to the filled in heart stamp and stamp randomly on the page as desired. You'll need to stamp the heart a total of five times. Reapply ink to the stamp as needed. Apply Festive Berries Distress Oxide Ink to the outlined heart stamp and stamp randomly on the page as desired. You'll need to stamp the outlined heart a total of eleven times. Reapply ink to the stamp as needed.




Next, you're going to be doing some cutting on your electronic machine. From the Be Mine Bundle, you'll need to cut the heart border out of Red Colour Vibe Cardstock. The border measures ¼" wide and 5 ¼" long. Make sure that you set aside thirteen of the hearts from the heart border as you will use them for embellishments on the page. Cut out the 14 circle out of Mint Colour Vibe Cardstock. I sized the circle down to 1 ¼" wide. Back the circle using one of the patterned papers out of the Happy Hearts Creative Kit. I thought I was going to use the gnome on my page but decided not to, that is why it is in the photo but not on the page. Cut out the arrows from a piece of black Colour Vibe Cardstock. The arrows measure ¾" wide. Choose two of the arrows and set the other one aside for a future project.



Cut out the Hearts & Garland Wreath out of a piece of Warm White Colour Vibe Cardstock. I sized the wreath down to 5'' wide. I cut the wreath down to $3 \frac{3}{4}''$. Back the hearts with patterned paper out of the Happy Hearts Creative Kit.



Cut the Heart Background out of Peony Colour Vibe Cardstock. I sized the background down to 6". Cut two of the heart strips vertically off the background. Then cut the two heart strips in half vertically.



Next, cut the ABC Love Background out of Black Colour Vibe Textured Cardstock. I sized the background down to 5 7/8". Cut 3 3/8" off the background piece. Sand the edges of the background piece.



Adhere the heart border strip to the left-hand side of the ABC Background piece as desired. Adhere the ABC Background piece 1" from the right and 1 3/8" from the bottom of the white cardstock piece.



Staple one of the heart background strips 2" from the left and 7/8" from the bottom of the white cardstock piece. Staple the second heart background strip 1 ½" from the right and ½" from the bottom of the white cardstock piece.



Adhere the one of the black arrows slightly on top of the bottom of the ABC Background as desired. Adhere the second black arrow about $\frac{1}{2}$ " underneath the first arrow as desired. Use foam squares to adhere the heart wreath $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the left and 1 1/8" from the bottom of the white cardstock piece.



Foam square the 14 circle in amongst the two hearts in the bottom portion of the garland & heart wreath. To finish the page, adhere the thirteen hearts from the heart border strip as desired.
